Development of knowledge and competence

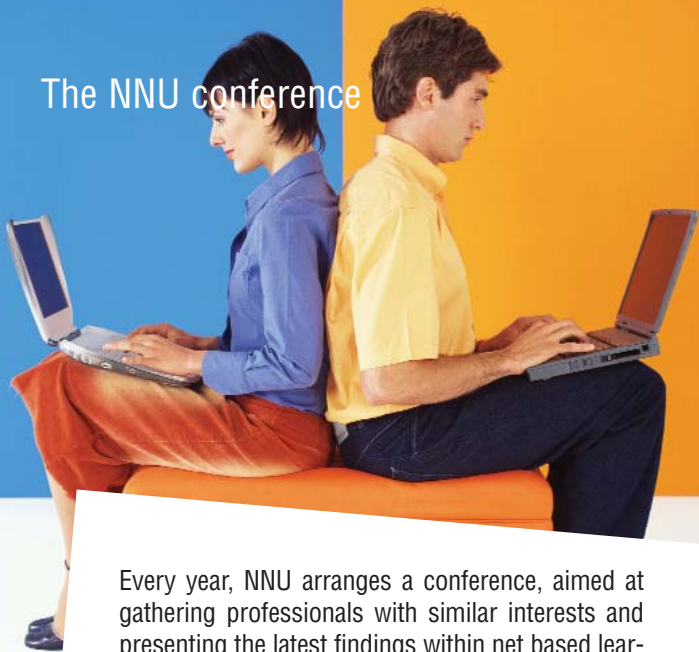
NNU promotes development of knowledge and competence within net based learning for its members. Every year there are externally and internally financed projects within flexible and distant learning.
